Rules

1. The competition is open to all
2. The term experimental should be taken to mean that the movie should push the envelope of movie making in theme, methodology or script. It may or may not have a narrative basis. It is not expected that a traditional movie or documentary will be successful.
3. Maximum duration is 30 mins.
4. While the preferred format is PAL the NTSC format will be accepted.
5. Entries should be provided on DVD, Blu-Ray, mini DV or mini HDV. VHS, beta or film will not be accepted.
6. Dialogue to be in English or with English language subtitles.
7. Only one entry per disc or tape.
8. Multiple entries will be accepted.
7. The disc or tape label must clearly show the movie title, aspect ratio and the entrant's name. The container for the disc or tape should, also, display the movie title, aspect ratio and the entrant's name. (All discs must be "Finalised".)
8. Copyright clearance is the responsibility of the entrant, and the BVMA will not accept any responsibility or condone the illegal use

of any music, video clips, photographs, or any other material used in the productions.

9. The producer should provide a short statement (about 75 words max) explaining in what manner the movie is experimental.
10. Movies suitable for adult viewing are eligible and will not be disadvantaged in the judging procedure, however, because the prizewinning viewing will be open to an unrestricted audience, such movies may not be shown.
11. Credits must not include any results from other competitions.
12. The Committee reserves the right to copy entries for screening purposes. The owner shall retain full copyright.
13. Submitted media will not be returned.
14. Closing date is 15th November 2009.
15. Results will be notified to all finalists by 28th Feb 2010.
16. Members of the Committee of BVMA are ineligible.
17. The judges' decision will be final.
